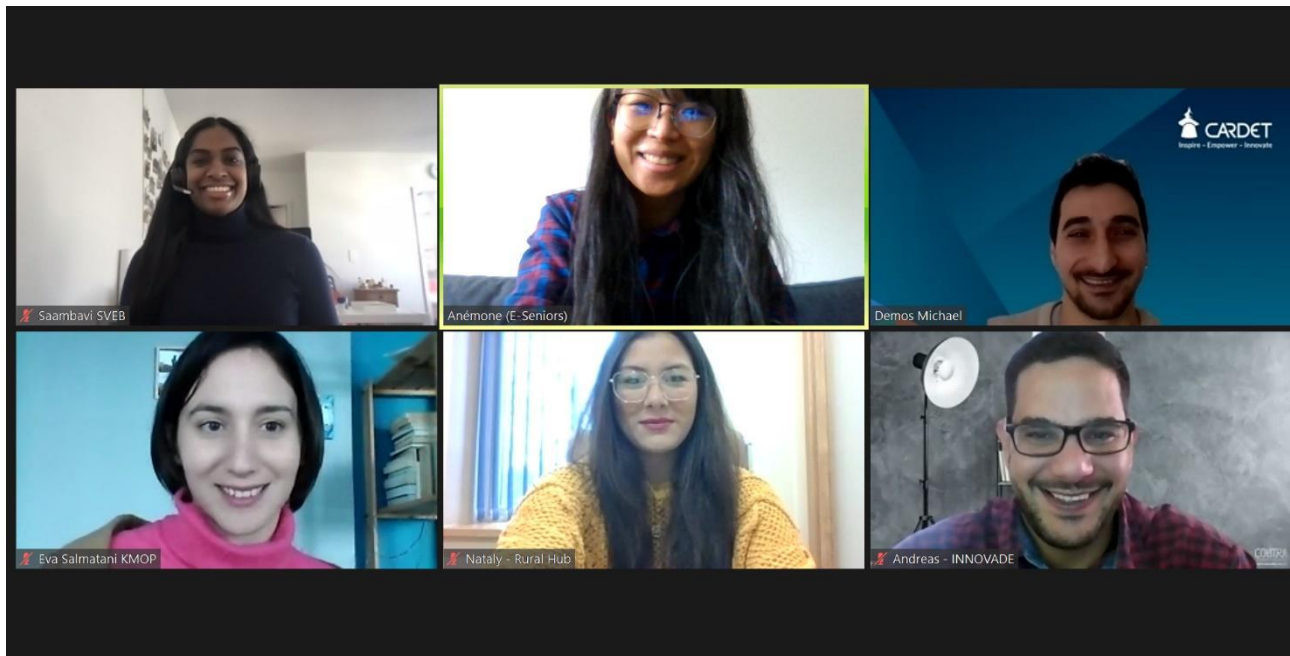


e-Protect 3rd Newsletter

Based on the result of IO1, the [Competency Scale](#), the partners achieved the development of the IO2, the **e-Protect Curricula**.
